

## Quarantine for the beginning of Cloister Time

Please read this section on quarantine carefully if your son is returning to the UK in April for the beginning of Cloister Time. If you have not already done so, please would you complete this <u>form</u> whether or not your quarantine arrangements in April are at Winchester College.

## Quarantine at Winchester College

If you have signed up, or would like to sign up for our quarantine facility, then you must complete <u>this</u> form to book the **test to release** with our testing partners, Diagnostics for the Real World (DRW). It is an official form and part of the government's **test to release scheme** and needs to be signed. Please print it out, complete **in** the name of the pupil and scan it and return it to Mrs Cullerne (<u>kkc@wincoll.ac.uk</u>). The charges for this test, and the test at entry to our quarantine facility, are included in the quarantine facility fee of £1350.

Advice on completing the form:

- You will need to complete the top half of the form.
- In "Self-isolate address" section, please put Winchester College.
- In the "Referred by" section, please circle Travel.
- Please don't worry about the NHS number. We will complete that section.
- Please put Dr John Cullerne and <u>ipc@wincoll.ac.uk</u> into the section "Name of Referring person".
- Please don't forget to print name and sign in the name of the pupil. Please leave the date blank so we can fill it in on the day the test is done.

Once we have your DRW form we will provide you with a DRW test reference number, which you will need to complete your **passenger locator form**. You must complete the passenger locator form online before you arrive in the UK (here is a <u>link</u>). You can submit the passenger locator form any time in the 48 hours before your son arrives in the UK.

## Pupils from Red List countries

Pupils returning from <u>Red List</u> countries may use our quarantine facility, but cannot use the **test to release scheme**. They will quarantine separately from the other arrivals and must complete their 10 days of self-isolation.

## Quarantine Elsewhere

If you would like to organise your own quarantine arrangements please read the following advice on entering the UK: <u>link</u>. In order to help you with your planning, the arrangements for the staggered return and COVID-19 testing on the SAMBA system from 19 April are as follows:

Testing	Booking availability
VI Book 1 (Year 13)	0800 – 1830 Monday 19 April
V Book (Year 11)	0800 – 1830 Tuesday 20 April



VI Book 2 (Year 12)	0800 – 1830 Wednesday 21 April
Middle Part (Year 10)	0800 – 1830 Thursday 22 April
Junior Part (Year 9)	0800 – 1830 Friday 23 April
Overspill (any year group)	As required Saturday 24 April

The booking system for SAMBA testing will open shortly and we will give parents notice. We will also be sending parents the e-mail containing their son's unique identifier so that they can make the booking.
