

Pupil Protocols in Common Time 2021

Please maintain these basic protocols:

- Maintain 1 metre distance from other pupils where possible: see "Use of face coverings" below
- Maintain 2 metre distance from staff where possible

Use face coverings

- in all lessons unless social distancing is possible. Please note that this will be in the majority of classes, and is a government directive. If you cannot wear a face covering for medical reasons we will ask for an exemption from the Medical Centre
- going to and between classes
- if asked to do so

You do not need to wear face coverings going to ekker unless your activity precludes social distancing.

Keep face coverings in a sealable container.

For class

- Carry all equipment in day sack
- Face forwards in lessons where possible
- Use the classroom seating plan given to you by your don: this is essential for tracing
- Wash hands; avoid touching your face and surfaces
- Wipe desks and chairs at the end of lessons
- Avoid raising your voice
- Follow the one-way system during lesson times.

If you feel unwell, tell a member of staff immediately.

In addition:

- Please observe social distancing when encountering members of the public on the pavement.
 Be particularly sensitive towards the elderly, many of whom feel vulnerable during the pandemic
- Please carry your own hand sanitiser with you when you are away from the house
- Please follow the one-way system during up-to-books hours
- The prohibition on Kingsgate Street and Kingsgate Road applies in up-to-books hours only
- P&G Wells, Kingsgate Books & Prints and Cornflowers are closed at present, but you may be able to arrange times to collect orders
- KPO may only be visited by pupils in VI Book
- Pupils must stay on campus and not go into town except for medical appointments by prior arrangement with their housemasters, or under the terms set out by the Second Master.
